
Notice Inviting Expression of Interest

Terms and Conditions

1. Nature of Job:


- To assist and give technical inputs to the matters related to Conservation works.
- Assist in the preparation and processing of the RCP, Estimates and Tenders in Conservation Section of ASI.
- Handling the Conservation Portal issues including processing of proposals
- Any other work in the field of conservation and World Heritage that may be assigned from time to time by higher authorities as well as routine matters.
- Assist in the matters related to Science Branch & Horticulture Branch

2. Eligibility

- Essential Qualification:-
Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized institution/university.
Diploma in Civil Engineering from a recognized institution.
- Experience: Minimum working experience of 3 years in the field of Conservation/Modern construction works for degree holder & of 5 years in the field of Conservation/Modern construction works for diploma holder.
- The candidate should have sufficient knowledge in computer applications such as MS office and other, GIS applications, etc.

3. Duration of Consultancy.

- For one year from the date of appointment.



4. Remuneration/Consultancy Charges

- The remuneration of Consultant is Rs.40,000 (Rupees Forty Thousand Only) per month (Consolidated) for degree holder and Rs.30,000 (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) per month (Consolidated) for diploma holder. Consultancy fee would be lump sum amount and no other allowance such as DA,HRA, Transport Allowance etc. would be payable. The appointment would be purely on temporary contract basis.
5. The Consultant will be entitled for leave as applicable for contract posts.
 6. No medical allowance will be paid during the contract.
 7. The working days will be same as that of a regular ASI employee. The Consultant shall be based in ASI headquarter, Delhi.
 8. In the course of providing the services, the consultant shall act in a professional manner exercising all due diligence, care, skill and judgment and provide the service promptly, carefully in accordance with the milestones and as per the standard required by the ASI. Consultants may observe and comply with all applicable procedures as laid down by the ASI.
 9. During this period, the consultant will not undertake any other contract/assignment.
 10. The consultant agree to maintain confidentiality of the work and its outcome as demanded by the ASI.
 11. The services of the contract personnel can be terminated at any time by giving a notice of one month on either side i.e by the contract personnel or the appointing authority. The appointing authority may pay the contract personnel his/her pay and allowance for the period of one month or for the period by which notice period falls short of one month and terminate his/her services immediately.
